Brian Taylor is Professor of Social Work at Ulster University, where he leads the research cluster on Decision, Assessment, Risk and Evidence Studies in Social Work as well as contributing to qualifying and post-qualifying social work training. He joined the University after ten years' experience in practice and management, and fifteen years in training and organization development in health and social care.

Abstract:

Assessment is a well-established practice that is central to social work. However there have been developments in recent years in our understanding of risk factors; in the demands to show that decisions are based on best evidence; and in our conceptualisation of how people make judgements. These will influence increasingly the tools and processes of assessment. The pace of development is likely to increase with the use of mathematical calculations and computer algorithms to estimate the likelihood of particular harms occurring, and with the development of computer-aided approaches to decision making. This talk will take an overview of key developments in assessment, risk and decision making that are shaping future practice. The focus will be on family and child care work, although the principles and points raised will be applicable across all fields of social work practice, and for other human service professions.
